Warm & Toasty

The Reconstruction \$3.79
We decided to “reconstruct” the old “Prairie Lawyer” into this traditional “Caprese-style” panini sandwich. Roma tomatoes are sliced and layered with fresh basil leaves and smoked provolone cheese on sourdough.

The Missouri Compromise \$5.29
There is really no need to compromise with this tasty panini! We take turkey and combine it with bacon, cheddar cheese and ranch dressing and grill it all between two slices of sourdough bread.

Ulysses S. Grant Panini \$5.99
He probably never had it, but we’re sure he would have loved it! This grilled sourdough panini features a chicken breast with melted parmesan cheese and a delightful pesto sauce.

Privateer’s Demise \$5.69
Before they were outlawed, privateers spread culture and wealth from the Caribbean throughout the coastal United States. One such delicacy could have been this sourdough panini, had it existed at the time. Jerk seasoned chicken combines with bacon, pineapple, Monterey Jack cheese and honey mustard in this tasty combination of sweet and hot.

The San Francisco \$4.99
This teriyaki chicken panini could very well have been brought to the States from the East with the first major wave of Chinese immigrants in the late 1850’s and early 1860’s. Tangy teriyaki marinade joins with pineapple, chicken breast and rice noodles to create a unique Asian fusion flavor. We’ve struck the Comstock Load with this one!

The Honest Abe \$5.29
This delectable sandwich is piled high with thinly sliced top inside round roast beef on a toasted ciabatta roll served with Au Jus. We can’t tell a lie, this sandwich is fantastic!

The Railsplitter \$5.79
Top inside round roast beef joins with tomatoes and sharp cheddar cheese on this toasted sourdough panini. The word is out—this platform is tasty!

Commander in Cheese \$4.89
The name says it all! American, Swiss and Colby Jack cheese are sandwiched between two grilled sourdough slices of bread crusted with Parmesan. “4 Cheese and seven years ago...”

The Southern Belle Buffalo Wrap \$6.29
“Winner of the 2008 Abe’s Best Recipe Contest”
The name may sound dainty, but it has a kick that will satisfy the heartiest of appetites. Crunchy homestyle chicken strips are covered with a spicy buffalo sauce and wrapped in a tortilla with lettuce, tomato, cheese and ranch dressing.

This tasty Bistro creation features chicken fingers, bacon, lettuce and tomato sandwiched between two slices of mayo-covered toasted wheat bread.

The Presidential Club \$5.79
The leading sandwich of the free world! Smoked ham, turkey and bacon combine with mayo, Swiss and American cheese, fresh lettuce and tomatoes on your choice of whole wheat or country white bread. To toast or not to toast, that is the question!

Gettysburg BLT \$4.29
